- R&D investment in Alberta's pharma industry is expected to grow at a CAGR of 3.7% over the next five years



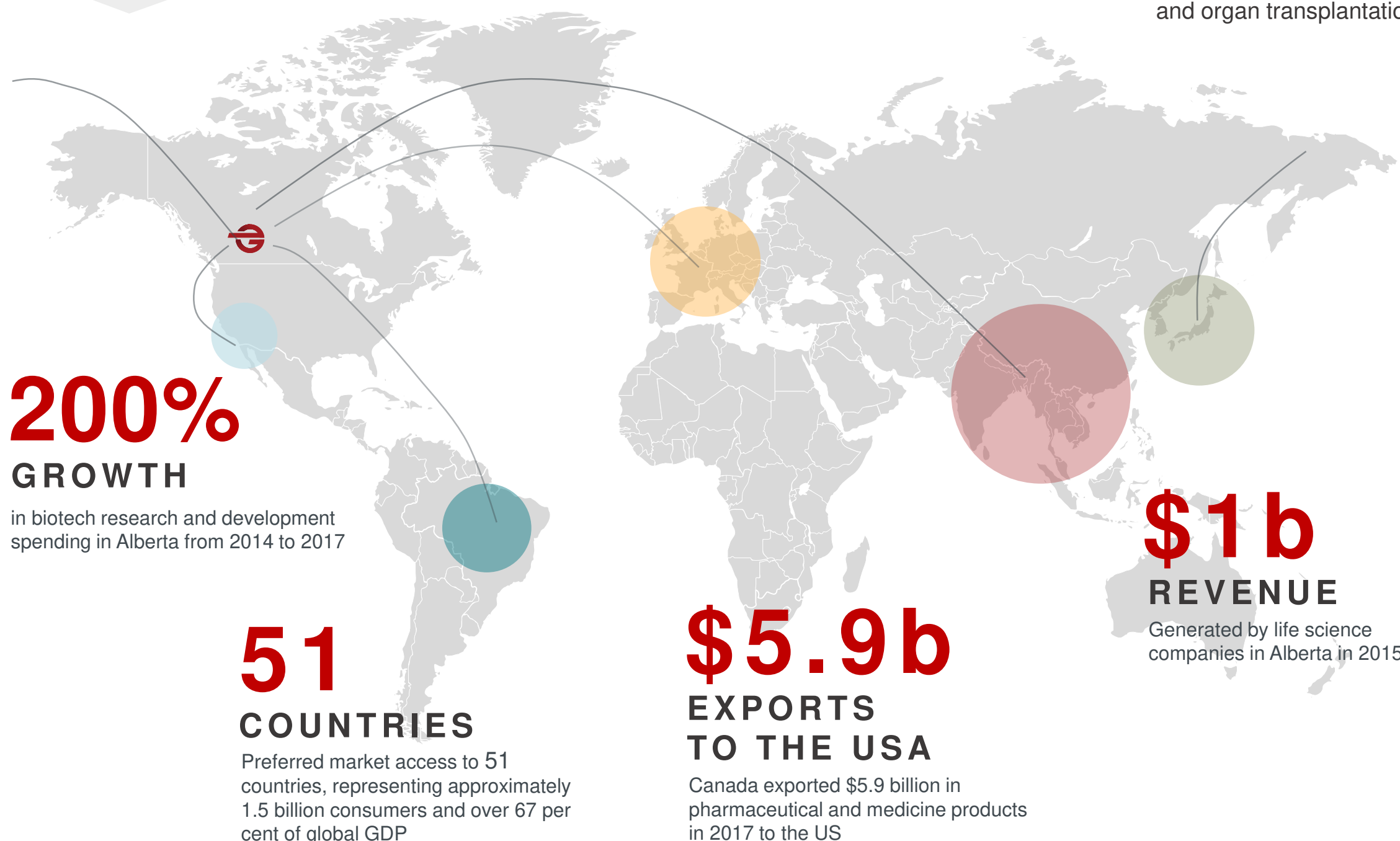
MEDICAL TECH AND DEVICES

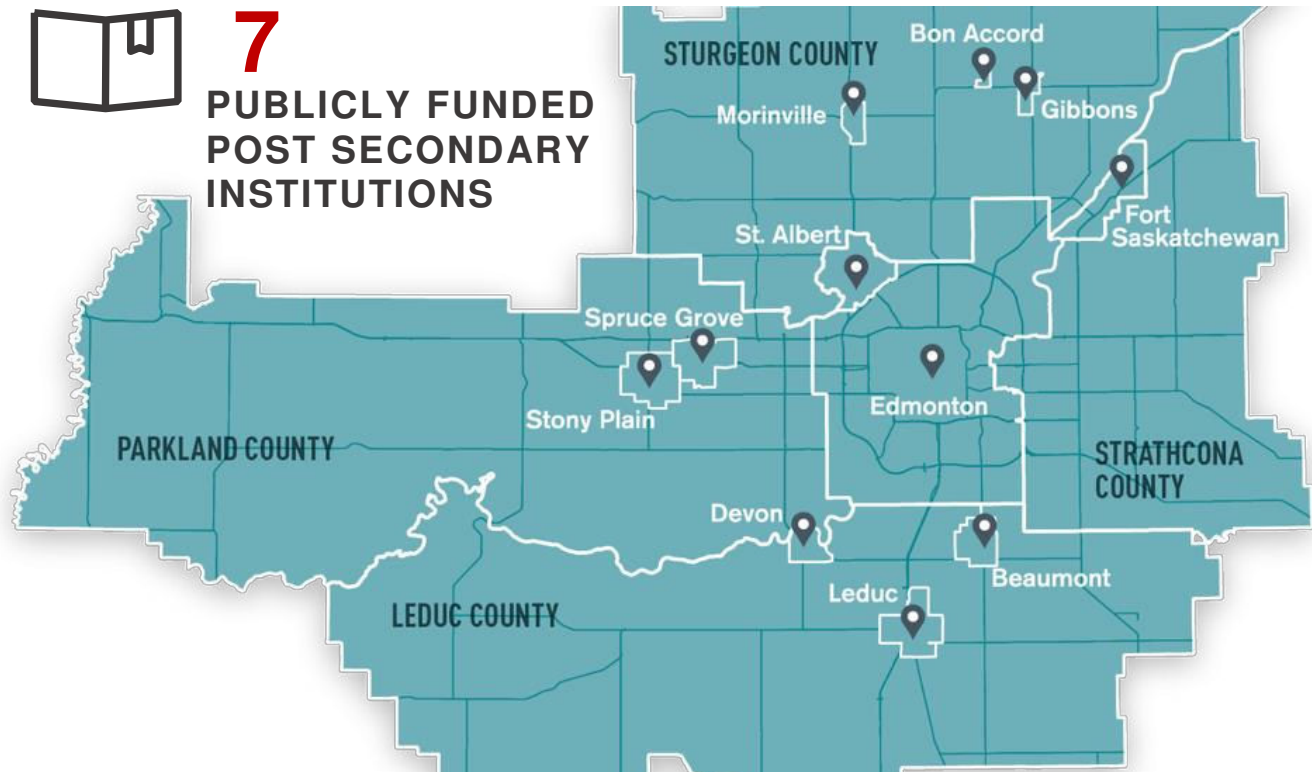
TALENT & EDUCATION
